The total amount of operational waste produced in 2022/23 academic year was 803,486kg, which equated to 40.6kg per person (from 19,803 FTE staff and students).

Financial Investments:

2022/23 saw an investment of £11,867 in waste facilities improvements.

Financial Savings:

The re-use of furniture and other items via the Warp-it platform in 2022/23, has saved the University £27,215 in waste disposal and procurement costs.

Since the 2015/16 baseline year, the strategic waste management activities have delivered cumulative savings of £1,015,000 against the predicted 'business as usual' costs (excluding hazardous waste). This is mainly down to three reasons: long-term trends in reducing the amount of waste generated; over-estimates of increases in waste costs which have not materialised within this timeframe; and the reduction in waste generated due to the COVID-19 shutdown at the University during 2020 and 2021. £170,000 of these savings were delivered in 2022/23.
