## Achievements this period:

- Significant stakeholders have been met and briefed on the programme including HR, CQSD, Staff Council, IMPS, Legal Services, UCU, TLSB, UBTL
- All day workshop held with the TEL Team to discuss plans and options
- Short workshop held with IT senior management to review requirements and plan activities. In addition met IT specialists to discuss potential security issues around EMA
- Project Managers have now been appointed for all 4 of the work streams that are commencing
- EMA Programme Board signed off the Programme Definition Document
- A draft "Digested Programme Definition Document" has been produced and is under review so that it can be available for interested parties as soon as possible
- Draft Terms of Reference (and a role description for Project Board Chair) have been circulated for comment
- Workshop held with Tribal (supplier of SITS) to explore possibilities and plan for work required
- Project Initiation Documents (PIDs) are in production for W/S 2 and W/S 3 (eSFG and Core Systems)
- The new EMA programme website has been built and is now in test

### Key Activities for next period:

- Initiating the governance boards for the Programme, in particular the Pedagogical Steering Group to commence discussions around the systemisation of assessment rules
- Workshop with IT to review possible security implications around EMA and necessary actions required to be built into plans
- Commencement of thinking around data requirements for the student feedback dashboard, to ensure design on other projects is aligned
- Continued effort on initiating W/S 1 (Change), W/S 2 (eSFG) and W/S 3 (Core Systems), with PIDs being signed off by the board where possible
- On boarding of new project manager for W/S 5 (Learning Analytics) ready for project initiation in April
- Initiation workshop to be held with Blackboard to explore work required and plan effort
- Meeting with the Degree Apprenticeship team to understand how the two pieces of work will interface and to attempt to ensure that EMA solutions are suitable for their needs
- Launch of EMA programme website
- Formal launch event for the programme on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2017, with a second being planned to accommodate the large number of colleagues wishing to attend


